Access To Healthy Food

Over 40%

of Walmart store sales in DC are from grocery items.

Each Walmart is located in a USDA identified food desert, where healthy food options make up less than 10% of local retail offerings.





Savings For Families

Walmart has brought affordable shopping to the District, saving the average family of four per year in groceries.



Average annual cost of food for a family of four is \$7,300.



Average discount below other chain grocery stores is 18%.
